

# T'WAS THE DAY AFTER EARTHDOG

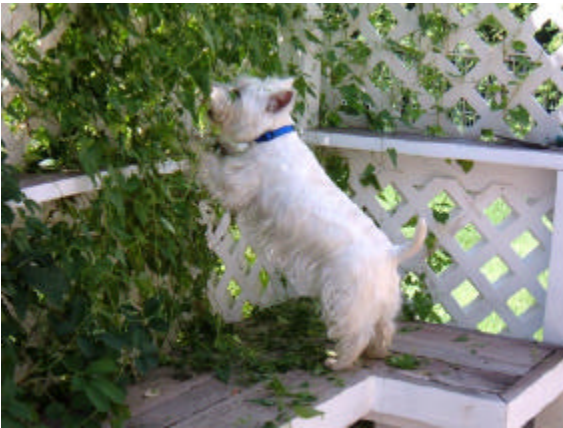

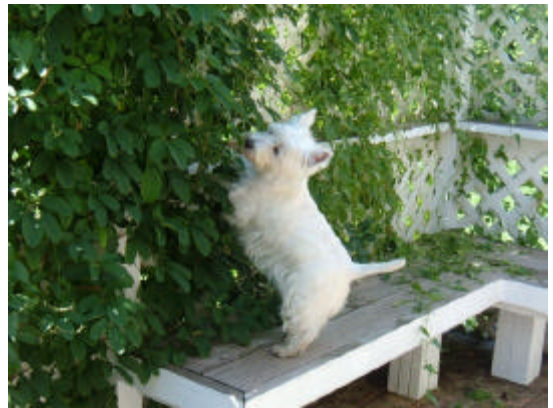
and all through the house,  
Westies were waiting for a new mouse!



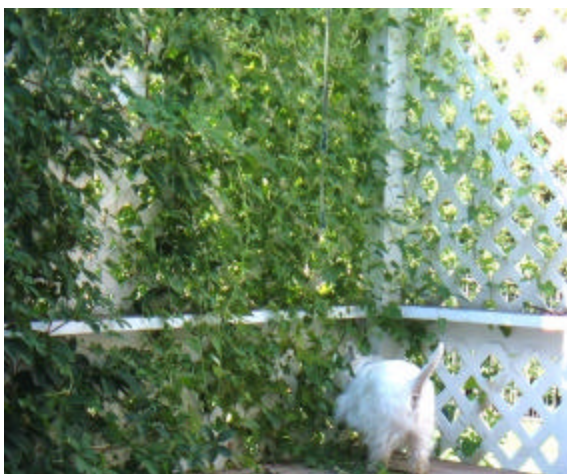
Molly, in her squirrel mode  
and I in my glory



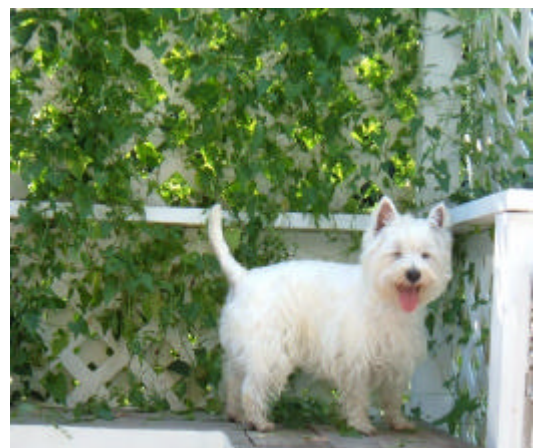
Vines were hung on the lattice with care

there



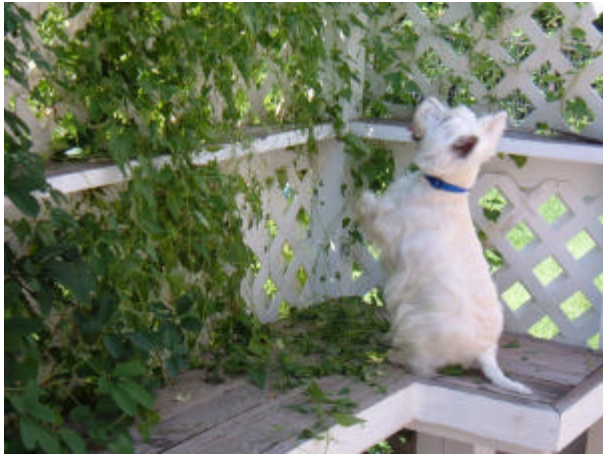
Are ready to tell that mouse,
